Instructions.

(1) In all cases, i.e., whether men are transferred in this country, to England, &c., or left behind by their units, this form will be prepared (by the carbon process provided the entries are made by an indelible or special copying pencil) in triplicate. One copy to be retained by the unit as a regimental record. Two copies to be sent as receipt and delivery vouchers to the new corps of each man transferred, the former being returned after signature. These vouchers will support issues and receipts in the public clothing ledgers.

(2) In the case of insanes the word “insane” will be written in red ink at the top of this form and the signature of the soldier will be omitted.

NOTE.—A manuscript statement showing the articles of personal clothing taken away should be prepared in the case of prisoners sent home, for discharge.
